Dear Valued Stakeholder,

In November 2017, the Technical Standards and Safety Authority (TSSA) launched stakeholder consultations regarding new fees proposed under the Boilers and Pressure Vessels (BPV) Safety Program. The proposed fees are as follows:

1. A new fee for a certificate of inspection (COI) issued as legal authorization to operate a BPV after a passed periodic inspection; and
2. An audit fee for insurers licensed to underwrite BPV equipment.

The proposed new fees result from changes to the BPV regulation designed to clarify the authorization process for regulated BPVs and enhance TSSA's oversight of periodic inspections conducted by insurers and third-party inspection providers.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between TSSA and the Ministry of Government and Consumer Services (MGCS) requires TSSA to foster transparency by consulting with applicable Industry Advisory Council(s) and get input from the Consumer Advisory Council (CAC) before approving new or revising existing fees. In line with this requirement, TSSA consulted with the following groups of stakeholders:

1. The Consumer Advisory Council (CAC)
2. The BPV Industry Advisory Council (BPVAC)
3. The BPV Industry Expert Panel
4. Insurance companies licensed to underwrite Boiler and Machinery Insurance
5. Third-party inspection agencies
6. Representatives of owners and manufacturers of BPV equipment

More information on these consultations can be found in minutes already shared or posted on TSSA's website.

To keep you updated on the outcome of these consultations, we are providing you with the following information regarding the BPV program fee schedule:

1. Certificate of Inspection (COI) Fee chargeable per device to owners of BPV devices for all COIs issued after a passed periodic inspection. The fee schedule is as follows:
  - \$40 for devices with an annual inspection cycle
  - \$80 for devices with a two-year inspection cycle
  - \$115 for devices with a three-year inspection cycle
2. A triennial audit fee of \$4,100 for insurers licensed to underwrite boiler and machinery insurance.

These new fees were approved by TSSA's Board on January 24, 2018 are effective July 1, 2018 when the amended regulation comes in-to-force.

Thank you for participating in the consultation process. TSSA will keep you updated with implementation of the amended regulation.
